

# Donate Life Vermont Poster Contest

School Year 2016-2017



## Contest Details:

The Donate Life VT Poster Contest is open to all Vermont high school students in grades 9-12.

Students are invited to create an awareness poster for organ and tissue donation.

Artwork must be original. No copyrighted or trademarked artwork will be accepted for judging with the exception of the Donate Life logo.

Your entry must include positive and accurate messaging about organ and tissue donation and include the phrase "organ and tissue donation".

Posters must be at least 8.5x11" and no larger than 18x24".

Leave a 1" border around your poster, no writing, image or drawing within 1" of the edges.

Your entry must not have grammatical or spelling errors.

Attach your completed official entry form to your poster (must be legible).

E-mail graphic design entries to [volunteerservices@neds.org](mailto:volunteerservices@neds.org) and include the entry form information.

Use materials that can be easily reproduced, such as paint, pencil, ink, charcoal, pastels, graphic design and photography, NOT folded, matted, laminated or framed.

Posters must be submitted and received by Friday, March 3, 2017.

Winners will be selected by a panel of judges based on criteria of originality, artistic merit and effective use of theme.
